Kit & Equipment Management Student Attachment (3 months)

Role Overview

The Kit & Equipment Management Attachment Student will be responsible for the organization, preparation, and maintenance of all training and match equipment.

Key Responsibilities

- Set up and pack down all training equipment for 4–5 weekly sessions
- Manage inventory of equipment (cones, bibs, balls, poles, mannequins, goals, etc.)
- Ensure all equipment is clean, safe, and in good working condition
- Organize and maintain equipment storage areas for efficiency and accessibility
- Prepare and distribute training bibs and gear before sessions
- Set up hydration stations and ensure availability of water and recovery items
- Assist coaches during sessions with quick equipment adjustments
- Support match-day logistics related to equipment and kit

Additional Responsibilities (if capable)

- Assist in organizing player kit (training/match gear)
- Track equipment usage and report shortages or damages
